High revalidation rates mean more professionals remain eligible to practise. Having enough nurses, midwives and nursing associates with the right skills makes a difference to the safety and quality of care people receive, and to their experience of that care.

In the last 12 months

94.4%

revalidated. An increase from 94 percent last year.

94.2%

of those educated in the UK revalidated.

95.4%

of those educated outside the UK and EU revalidated.

93.4%

of those educated inside the EU revalidated.

Revalidation rates by profession have remained consistent since 2016 and are comparable with proportions on our register.



Revalidation rates are consistent across the four nations of the UK, with most professionals revalidating in the same UK country in which they were educated.
